- State Recognized Programs of Study (S-R POS) - The Pieces:
 - Alignment to Needed Pathway Skills
 - Partnerships
 - MDE Program Approval
 - Minnesota State Academic Requirements
 - Sufficient Materials, Equipment or Resources
 - Authentic Work Experience
 - Supported by CLNA
- S-R POS May or May Not Need Funding

- To Have All 6 Fields Covered

Compliance or More?

- Because Federal Regulations Require It
- To Demonstrate MN Perkins Requirements
 - Minimum of 4 Fields Covered by S-R POS
 - Maximum of 1 Brokered S-R POS
- Align POS to CLNA priorities
- To be a Resource for Stakeholders





Funding Priorities



- Program of Study (POS)
 - MDE Program Approval
 - Minnesota State Academic Requirements
 - Supported by CLNA
- POS Could be S-R POS in the Making
- POS Reflect the Need for Support & Development





Reporting POS for Previous Two-Year Plan

 Consortia provided information through Amplifund



 State team accumulated information into a spreadsheet matrix for each consortia






Issues with Amplifund



- Not easy to meet federal requirements for posting POS information
- Separate Amplifund screen for each POS—not easy to communicate POS information to stakeholders
- New two-year plan would require completion of all screens again...even if no changes to Programs of Study



New Spreadsheet Tool to Replace Amplifund for POS Submission



Benefits:

- Ability to copy/paste POS information into future applications
- Better stakeholder communication tool—POS information can be displayed on one sheet
- NO LIMIT to number of State-Recognized POS that can be reported (must verify each complies with all 7 components)
- Separates State-Recognized POS reporting from "POS funding priorities"
