

Subgroups of students as specified in Section 1111(c)(2)(B) of the **Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965**:

- A. economically disadvantaged students
- B. students from major racial and ethnic groups
- C. children with disabilities
- D. English learners

Special populations of students specified in Sec 3(48) of the **Strengthening Career and Technical Education for the 21<sup>st</sup> Century Act**:

- A. individuals with disabilities;
- B. individuals from economically disadvantaged families, including low-income youth and adults;
- C. individuals preparing for non-traditional fields;
- D. single parents, including single pregnant women;
- E. out-of-workforce individuals;
- F. English learners ;
- G. homeless individuals described in section 725 of the McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act (42 U.S.C. 11434a);
- H. youth who are in, or have aged out of, the foster care system; and
- I. youth with a parent who— (i) is a member of the armed forces (as such term is defined in section 101(a)(4) of title 10, United States Code); and (ii) is on active duty (as such term is defined in section 101(d)(1) of such title.
