

- » Understand the process to request reallocation funding








Reallocation

- » Perkins V, Section 133(b)
- » Federal Perkins funds not expended at the local level within the academic year are returned to the state for redistribution
- » Perkins grant funds awarded July 1, 2023
- » FIFO All reallocated funds must be drawn down before funds awarded in July 2024 (Current Year)
- » Review your local approved application and determine where to apply reallocated funds




