What is Single Sign On for Minnesota State enterprise applications?

Minnesota State enterprise applications that allow Single Sign On and use StarID credentials for log in enable you to log in to one application by entering the StarID and password, and then open another application in the same browser without needing to enter the StarID and password again.

1. Single Sign On is already available for:
 - a. Mediaspace.minnstate.edu (media server)
 - b. Servicedesk.minnstate.edu (IT Service Desk)
 - c. Webmeeting.minnstate.edu (Adobe Connect web conferencing)
 - d. and more applications will enable single sign on in the future
2. Adding Single Sign On for D2L will be:
 - a. Convenient for faculty and students who are **enrolled in courses at more than one** Minnesota State institution
 - b. Convenient for faculty and staff who use Mediaspace, IT Service Desk, Adobe Connect web conferencing

Single Sign On Sequence (example)

1. Log in to D2L Brightspace at a school—enter StarID and password
2. Go to D2L Brightspace at a different school—no need to enter StarID/password
3. Go to Mediaspace.minnstate.edu – no need to enter StarID/password
4. Leaving one of the above sites will not affect the other sites
5. It is recommended to close all applications and browsers when finished with your work.

Schedule for Implementing Single Sign On at D2L Brightspace Sites

QA On Premise single sign on is currently available (March 2018)

Production On Premise single sign on will be rolled out to campuses throughout April 2018

QA Cloud roll out in late April-early May

Production Cloud will have single sign on as of June 2 after the migration to the cloud is completed, pending successful rollout and testing in our other D2L Brightspace environments.
